Staff Update: Kathlene Woltemath Recreation Director presents a folder to the board members that has marketing and pricing from 2005 to present day, pricing of other local recreational districts in Northern Colorado, and participation numbers over the last few years to show the growth of the programs. Kathlene speaks more in depth about Thompson Rivers Parks & Recreation's pricing per program, field capacity, and the cost behind the scenes that consists of referees, employees, field prep, and outsource facility space.
